### Instruction for authors of the proceedings of the conference

Abstracts of the conference planned to be published to the beginning of the conference. The manuscripts need to be presented till 10<sup>th</sup> September 2020. Languages of publications are Russian and English.

The abstracts should not exceed 1 page. Organizing Committee keeps responsibility for acceptance/rejection of submitted abstracts.

Abstracts are submitted via e-mail of the conference Petersburg@yandex.ru. Submitting abstracts the author confirms that his relationships with co-authors and third parties are settled.

Abstracts must be fully prepared for publication, checked for language and the following rules. Manuscripts with numerous technical and orthographic errors are not acceptable. English editing is a responsibility of author(s).

Abbreviations of authors of taxa should follow

Abstracts for publications are submitted in docx or rtf format, for abstract file name the name of the first author in Latin letters must be used. Font Times New Roman, 13 pt, 1-spaced; the title in bold, authors address — 12 pt; upper, lower, left and right margins — 2.5 cm. Double, triple and multiple spaces, tabulator signs, automatic numbering and other “extra” formatting as well as use of spaces between letters instead of sparse spacing in terms and words that need to be emphasized are not allowed. Never use CapsLock. When necessary use option ALL CAPITALS.
