

**Publication ethics and malpractice statement of *Novosti sistematiki nizshikh rastenii* —  
*Novitates Systematicae Plantarum non Vascularium***

**1. Publication and authorship:**

- list of references, financial support;
- no plagiarism, no fraudulent data;
- forbidden to publish the same results in more than one journal.

**2. Author's responsibilities:**

- authors obligated to participate in peer review process;
- all the authors have significantly contributed to the research;
- statement that all the data in the article are real and authentic;
- all the authors are obligated to provide retractions or corrections of errors.

**3. Peer review / responsibility for the reviewers:**

- judgments should be objective;
- reviewers should have no conflict of interest with respect to the research, the authors and/or the research funding organizations;
- reviewers should point out relevant published work which was not cited by the authors;
- reviewed articles should be treated confidentially.

**4. Editorial responsibilities:**

- editors have complete responsibility and authority to reject/accept an article;
- editors should have no conflict of interest with respect to articles they reject/accept;
- only accept a paper when reasonably certain;
- when serious errors are found, promote publication of correction or retraction of the published article;
- preserve anonymity of reviewers.

**5. Publishing ethics issues:**

- monitoring/safeguarding publishing ethics by editorial board;
- guidelines for retracting articles;
- maintain the integrity of the academic record;
- preclude business needs from compromising intellectual and ethical standards;
- always be willing to publish corrections, clarifications, retractions and apologies when needed;
- no plagiarism, no fraudulent data.
